



Complete this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for the following amounts on your Form TD1, 2010 Personal Tax Credits Return.

Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

Line 3 of Form TD1 – Age amount

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2010, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$32,506 and \$75,480, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Table for Line 3 of Form TD1 - Age amount calculation. Includes rows for Maximum amount (6,446.00), Your estimated net income for the year, Base amount (32,506.00), Line 2 minus line 3, Applicable rate (15%), Multiply line 4 by line 5, and Line 1 minus line 6.

Line 9 of Form TD1 – Caregiver amount

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$14,422 and \$18,645, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Table for Line 9 of Form TD1 - Caregiver amount calculation. Includes rows for Base amount (18,645.00), Your dependant's estimated net income for the year, Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223), Enter the amount you claimed on line 8, and Line 3 minus line 4.

Line 10 of Form TD1 – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 9 of Form TD1. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,992 and \$10,215, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Table for Line 10 of Form TD1 - Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older calculation. Includes rows for Base amount (10,215.00), Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year, Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223), Enter the amount you claimed on line 8, and Line 3 minus line 4.
