<b>Line 2 of Form TD1NS – Age amount</b>			
If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2010, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$29,919 and \$56,713, calculate your partial claim as follows:

<b>Line 6 of Form TD1NS – Spouse or common-law partner amount</b>			
If your spouse's or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year (including the income earned before and during the marriage or common-law relationship) will be between \$699 and \$7,688, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Your spouse's or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year		–	2

Enter this amount on line 6 of Form TD1NS.			
<b>Line 7 of Form TD1NS – Amount for an eligible dependant</b>			
If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$699 and \$7,688, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Your eligible dependant's estimated net income for the year		–	2
Line 1 minus line 2			3
Enter this amount on line 7 of Form TD1NS.			
<b>Line 8 of Form TD1NS – Caregiver amount</b>			
If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$13,274 and \$18,027, calculate your partial claim as follows:			
Base amount		18,027   00	1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year		–	2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,753)		=	3
Enter the amount you claimed for this dependant on line 7 of Form TD1NS		–	4
Line 3 minus line 4			5
Enter this amount on line 8 of Form TD1NS.			
<b>Line 9 of Form TD1NS – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older</b>			
You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NS. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,515 and \$8,231, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year		–	2
