Complete this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for the following amounts on your Form TD1NU, 2010 Nunavut Personal Tax Credits Return.

Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

**Line 2 of Form TD1NU – Age amount**

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2010, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$32,506 and \$91,080, calculate your partial claim as follows:

**Line 8 of Form TD1NU – Caregiver amount**

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$14,422 and \$18,645 calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223)	=			3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of your TD1NU form for this dependant				4
Line 3 minus line 4				5
Enter this amount on line 8 of Form TD1NU				

**Line 9 of Form TD1NU – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older**

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NU. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,992 and \$10,215, calculate your partial claim as follows:
