

Complete this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for the following amounts on your Form TD1YT, 2010 Yukon Personal Tax Credits Return.

Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

Line 3 of Form TD1YT – Age amount		
If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2010, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$32,506 and \$75,480, calculate your partial claim as follows:		
Maximum amount		6,446 00 1
Your estimated net income for the year		2
Base amount	– 32,506 00	3
Line 2 minus line 3 (if negative, enter "0")	=	4
Applicable rate	× 15%	5
Multiply line 4 by line 5	=	▶ 6
Line 1 minus line 6		7

Line 9 of Form TD1YT – Caregiver amount		
If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$14,422 and \$18,645, calculate your partial claim as follows:		
Base amount		18,645 00 1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year		– 2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223)		= 3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 8 of your TD1YT form for this dependant		– 4
Line 3 minus line 4		= 5
Enter this amount on line 9 of Form TD1YT		
Line 10 of Form TD1YT – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older		
You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 9 of Form TD1YT. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,992 and \$10,215, calculate your partial claim as follows:		
Base amount		10,215 00 1
Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year		– 2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223)		= 3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 8 of your TD1YT form for this dependant		– 4
Line 3 minus line 4		= 5
Enter this amount on line 10 of Form TD1YT
